## Lochmere Highlands Ad Hoc Traffic Committee Traffic Calming Plan February 4, 2022

Since the Lochmere Highlands Ad Hoc Traffic Committee was created by the Lochmere Homeowners' Association Board of Directors in July 2017, there have been countless committee meetings (including some attended by staff from the Town of Cary Transportation Department), hundreds of emails, neighborhood meetings and much discussion about how to address the now well documented speeding issue along Loch Highlands Drive.

After all of this work, and coordinating closely with Town staff, a Traffic Calming Plan was presented to residents in an online meeting on July 29, 2021. The plan and the survey responses following the meeting, led to additional conversation, clarifications, and understanding.

On December 20, 2021, after reviewing all of the work we had done and the Traffic Calming Plan from the Town staff, the Traffic Committee recommended that the Board of Directors adopt the Traffic Calming Plan that the Town had proposed. At its regular monthly meeting on December 21, the Board accepted the Committee's recommendation, and, on December 22, Andy Siouville, Lochmere On-Site Community Manager, notified the Town staff.

The Committee knows that there are many questions on your minds. Hopefully, we will answer your questions on the attached FAQ page. The FAQ page will be updated periodically when necessary.

The implementation of the Traffic Calming Plan will take time. Please be patient.
