He replied that he and his team have been working on several projects in addition to ours.

He said that they have been developing a plan for the scope of the traffic calming measures. He said that they should start working on those things they can do now while they continue to develop plans for the more labor-intensive portions, for example, collecting signatures. His team will be working with Public Works to review sign relocations and looking into ordering the radar speed limit signs.

The design for the traffic circle (Loch Highlands Drive at Piperwood Drive/Glenrose Lane) will take some time but they have been working on an estimate which would help us get started on our signatures effort.

He said that he hoped to have a package of info ready to go prior to the end of this month.

In reply, I asked David for clarification and asked for the following things.

- 2. A list of the things he can do now. Will any work be started before the committee sees the plan?
- 3. A list of decisions about sign relocations.
- 4. If there are options for the radar speed limit signs, please send us links/photos/features of the signs under consideration.
- 5. If there is an updated/annotated map for the project, please send that along, too.

He thanked me for sending the list and said that he would cover everything. I will keep the Board posted.
